Opening General Session • 8:30 - 9:45 am *Metaphor Making for Counseling and Case Discussion*

Dr. Norman Amundson, University of British Columbia



Metaphors are an integral piece of storytelling and can be used as an analytic and intervention tool for counseling and case discussion. Metaphors are creative and useful ways of understanding and externalizing problems. There are several steps in this process, starting with Identification, moving to Elaboration, exploring various forms of Extension and Perspective Shifting, and then concluding with Reformulation. In this presentation I will be describing and illustrating the various processes with case examples. This information can be applied in many different professional contexts.

Dr. Norman Amundson is a Professor of Counselling Psychology at the University of British Columbia. He has given many national and international presentations and has published widely. His most recent publication is a 2018

anniversary edition of his award-winning book Active Engagement. Dr. Amundson's many accomplishments include the Eminent Career Award from NCDA and an honorary doctorate from the University of Umea in Sweden.

Dr. Brian Hutchison, New Jersey City University



Career services professionals sit at the junction of client personal fulfilment and their experience with important social systems (i.e., the world-of-work). Career choices are either restrained or enhanced by the fairness of employment systems. This interactive session will explore career services practice through a social justice lens. Attendees will leave with greater personal insight into their own career practice as it aids clients while striving for social justice.

Dr. Brian Hutchison is an Associate Professor at New Jersey City University and was formerly at the University of Missouri – Saint Louis. Dr. Hutchison is the President of the Asia Pacific Career Development Association (APCDA), Treasurer of the National Career Development Association (NCDA), Past President of the Missouri Career Development Association (MoCDA), Editor of the Asia Pacific Career Development Association journal, and Associate Editor of the Journal of Humanistic Counseling. His scholarship can be broadly described as focused

within two primary counseling domains, school counseling and career coaching/counseling. These broad themes are infused into three primary scholarship areas: international issues in career/ school counseling, career theory and practice integration, and counselor training/ education broadly defined.
