Committee Activities to Date

- Published new issues on the first of each month (except Jan. & July) bringing the total issues up to 242, since 2003 (Strategic Goal #2- Career Empowerment: Publications)
- Published 7 new articles, plus one Tech Tip, each month. Electronic distribution to over 30,000 emails on the first of the month and over 1700 articles archived
- Monitored auditory player plug-in, for users to listen to articles (Strategic Goal #1- Community: Engagement)
 - Avg monthly clicks this FY: 150 (same as last year); Highest Clicks: 240 (Nov); July lowest
- Achieved record-high hit rates for articles related to epilepsy, Schlossberg's theory, & burnout (Strategic Goal #2- Career Empowerment: Publications)
- Held virtual call with editorial team on December 10, 2025 and live meeting on July 1, 2026 at conference (Strategic Goal #1- Community: Engagement)
- Presented Career Convergence to conference participants in 2 sessions, and virtual conference
- Added 2 Field Editors; searching for 2 Assoc. Ed. (Strategic Goal #1- Community: Engagement)
- Selected winner (by editors' votes) the annual "Career Convergence Recognition Award" – Cynthia Snodgrass and Vonya Hodrick, winners (Strategic Goal #1- Community: Engagement)
- Published articles in cooperation with NCD A committees, e.g., Awards, LA, The Hub & NCD month (Strategic Goal #1- Community: Engagement)
- Social media each month handled by NCD A Social Media coordinator, with links to the issue and each article, increasing hit rates (Strategic Goal #1- Community: Recruitment)
